

# Franklin High School California Scholarship Federation

*Founded in 1921, the California Scholarship Federation (CSF) emphasizes high standards of scholarship for California high school students and recognizes Lifetime Members at graduation.*

Students may apply to become CSF members twice during each school year, September for Quarters 3 & 4 from the previous year, in January for Quarters 1 & 2 of the current school year. For seniors applying for 100% Lifetime Membership, one last application must be completed in May 2018. Sophomores are now eligible to apply.

*Freshmen are not eligible to apply.*

The following will be awarded to qualifying graduating seniors:

**Lifetime Membership:** Stole, Tassel, and Seal.

Requirements: Earn CSF Membership at least 4 times during 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

One session must be during the senior year. *Freshmen year grades do not count.*

**100% Lifetime Membership:** Gold Cord, Stole, Tassel, and Seal.

Requirements: Earn CSF Membership 6 times (every application period 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade).

*Freshmen year grades do not count.*

-----**READ CAREFULLY**-----

**Application-** To apply for CSF membership for Quarters 1 and 2 of 2017/2018 you must:

1. Earn a **minimum of 10 points** during Quarters 1 and 2 of 2017/2018 school year.
  - a. At least 4 points must be from LIST I. All points may come from List I
  - b. At least 7 points must be from LISTS I and II. All points may come from list I and II. (including the four points from LIST I)
  - c. The remaining 3 points may come from any LIST III. 3 Points maximum from List III.
2. Use **no more than 5 block courses** to qualify.
3. Use block grades only.
4. **Do not use the following:**
  - Pass/Fail Classes
  - Minis/Bridges
  - Physical Education
  - Courses taken in lieu of P.E.
  - Courses that were repeated to improve a grade
  - Teacher Assistant Courses
  - AP grades raised due to passing an AP test do not qualify.
5. If you earned a **D or F in any class** during these 2 quarters, you are disqualified and cannot apply until the next application period.
6. Check your application carefully before turning it into **the Concession Stand with your \$7.00 membership dues. All Applications are due to the concession stand by the end of 5<sup>th</sup> lunch on Wednesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>.**

*If you do not qualify your dues will be refunded.*
