- Check weekly: University Preview Days and College Visitation Schedules are in the Career Center and on the Franklin High School website.
- CSU's are voting on whether they will continue to use SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions. Ask your counselor for updated information in the spring. If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may be used as an alternative method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility or for course placement after you enroll.
