Private Colleges

- Explore private colleges and universities via their web sites. Visit www.aiccu.edu for links to private colleges **in California**. Make sure to check undergraduate admissions requirements.
- Explore www.collegeboard.org or www.commonapp.org for national and international private colleges.
- Review application and testing requirements for colleges and universities of interest; many private colleges use the Common Application for admissions. Common Application: www.commonapp.org
Be sure to read all directions and invite counselor and 2 teachers 3-4 weeks before application deadline.
- Check the testing requirements for each college. If necessary, complete your testing requirement for admission, either the SAT with Writing or the ACT with Writing:

- Look at the College Board’s **CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE** and check if your intended college requires it. After completing the application, the College Board sends the PROFILE to the colleges you have chosen. See website for more information:
