- □ The application to UC is available August 1st but can only be submitted October 1 -November 30. <u>Launch</u> your application through <u>www.CaliforniaColleges.edu</u>.
- In the Academic History section on the UC application, click on "Import courses & grades" and type in your SSID number to self-populate your grades. Your grades for 9th, 10th and first half of 11th grade will autofill. The only courses that should be typed into the application are for the second half of 11th grade and all 12th grade. (SSID is the acronym for Statewide Students Identifier and is found on the transcript)
- UC's will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions. If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may be used as an alternative method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility or for course placement after you enroll.
